

Note on Plastic Recycling Process

Plastic usage, an inevitable part of our daily lives, has grown over the years and plastics have turned out to be an alternative material in industry over the years. However, the unchecked growth in the volume of plastics is now posing an environment hazard and now warrants immediate concrete steps to prevent any adverse impact on the environment, by disposing of it in an appropriate & environment friendly way.

Our government has rightly banned usage of certain plastics and has assigned extended responsibility on each of the entities in the entire supply chain. This responsibility entails each user to put a mechanism in place for retrieval of the plastic used for their products supplied to customers.

Godrej & Boyce Mfg. Co. Ltd. has always been a responsible organisation in protecting the environment and extends full support to the authorities in implementing the ban on plastics. We seek your co-operation to make sure that plastic packaging on parts / products is not disposed as unsorted municipal waste.

Material Handling Division uses plastic of the defined grade with minimum thickness to ensure that the plastic can be recycled and re-used thereby reducing its impact on the environment.


Material Handling Division uses plastic to pack spare parts for MRP labelling, preserving while stocking & prevent in transit damage. The distribution channel for MHD Products and Spares is either direct to customers or through branches & dealers.

Spares purchased by the dealers are stocked and sold to customers who in turn will stock and use them as and when required.

For customers wanting to discard the plastic after un-wrapping the product / spares parts; need to segregate their plastic waste separately and ensure that it is disposed of through official plastic re-cyclers authorised by each state.
